- 2. Courageously generous people are not entitled.
 - » Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23
 - » James 1:3
- 3. Courageously generous people overflow with gratitude.
- 4. Courageously generous people are joyful
 - » Acts 20:35
 - » Generosity increases one's joy because it loosens a person's grip on this world and tightens their grip on Christ.
- 5. Courageously generous people don't ask "how much should I give?" but rather, "how much should I keep?"
- 6. Courageously generous people don't wait for someone to ask for help—they seek it out.
- 7. Courageously generous people have fewer material possessions than those with the same income.
- 8. Courageously generous people are content.
- Courageously generous people are not just generous with their money.
- 10. Courageously generous people are excited about life.
- 11. Courageously generous people are excited about eternity.
