

Scripture Memory Tools

Directions: Use the following checklist for ideas to help you memorize the verse. Choose 5-7 tasks or make up your own! You can memorize all the verses each week or just one verse.

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- Choose 3 people to say the verse to each day. This could include your pets!
- Copy your verse over and over in different colored markers or pens.
- Write your verse on the driveway in sidewalk chalk.
- Write your verse on your bathroom mirror using dry erase markers.
- Word Scramble - copy each word or set of words on index cards. Mix them up and put them in order again. Time yourself to see how fast you unscramble the verse
- Missing Word - write your verse on a poster board or dry erase board and cover words with a sticky note. Say the verse and fill in the missing words as you go.
- Draw It - Take each phrase or group words together and write them on sheets of paper. Draw a picture or symbol to help you memorize each phrase or group of words.
- Hot Potato: Ask a sibling, friend or parent to join you in practicing your verse by passing an object back and forth while saying each word of the verse.
- Follow the verse: Write your verse in phrases or groups of words on paper or index cards. Create a path in your home with each phrase in a different area. Follow the path to repeat the verse over and over.
- Erase a Word - Write the verse on a dry erase board or piece of paper. Erase a word. Then say the verse filling in the missing word. Repeat this with multiple words. Or, for an extra challenge, repeat until all the words are erased.
- Act It Out - Create hand motions for words or phrases.
- Record yourself saying the verse and send it to a friend or family member with your parents permission.
