

Creator - Family Lesson 4

Divine Attribute: God is Creator

Heart Response: Praise him

Memory Verse: Genesis 1:1 “In the beginning God made the heavens and the earth.”

Points of Emphasis:

1. God created everything.
2. Everything God made was good.
3. God created us in his image.

Optional printed memory verse poster

Open your Bible to Genesis 1:1. Show your child that this is where we find today’s verse in the Bible. Watch the memory verse video together. If you printed the memory verse poster, display it for your child to see. Practice the verse and motions with the video. Then, practice it as a family. Consider saying it in funny voices or as you stand, hop, or do other fun motions. Maybe even try making it a song!

Bible Lesson

***Note to - the lesson is written to be read like a story. Read the bold words aloud. The words in parenthesis give direction to pause, allow for response, or read Scripture.*

Supplies:

Bible

“Separating the Sky” gallon-sized bag with blue dish soap

Over the last few weeks, we learned that on day number one (hold up one finger) **God made day and night** (pretend to sleep as you say “night”).

And on day number two (hold up two fingers) **God created the sky to separate the waters** (use the baggy of water and draw your finger through the middle to show the waters separating). **On day three** (hold up three fingers), **God made all the land and the seas. And, God made the plants that grow on the land. On day number four** (hold up four fingers), **God made the sun, moon, and all the stars. Next, on day number five** (hold up five fingers) **God made everything in the water and God made the birds. Then, on day number six** (hold up six fingers) **God made the animals. But where were the people? When did God create people like us? On day six, God also made man!**

God said “Let us make man in our image.” So God created man and woman in his own image. God formed man out of the dust from the ground and breathed the breath of life into him (demonstrate breath by breathing into your hand and have your child try it). **He made us different from all the other animals.**

God created people in his image. God made you (point to your child) **and God made me** (point to yourself)! **God made _____** (you can name each member of your family).

Can you say “God made me”? (Have your child repeat that several times; encourage them to be louder and louder.) **God made each of us special. We have different eyes. Can you point to your eyes? We have different noses. Can you touch your nose? And we all have different fingerprints. Can you look at your fingers and find the tiny little lines on them? God created us and breathed life into each of us.**

God made everything in only six days. Can you count to six with me (point to your fingers and count to six with your child)? **And God looked over all he had made, and he saw that it was very good.**

Then on day seven, God rested from all his work. **Whew!** (Wipe brow as you say “Whew!”) And God declared the seventh day holy because it was the day he rested from all his work.

Let’s pray and thank God today for who he is and all he has made.

Prayer

Dear God, thank you for all you made. Thank you for creating us in your image. Help us learn to thank you and praise you with our whole hearts. Amen.

Creation Coloring Sheet

Review Questions

1. **Who made _____** (name of your child)? (God.)
2. **Who did God make in his image?** (Man, people, male, and female.)
3. **How did God create man?** (The dust from the ground, gave them the breath of life.)
4. **How did God create everything else?** (He spoke.)
5. **When God saw all he had made he said it was _____?** (Very good.)
6. **What are some animals God made?** (Fish, sheep, cows, dogs, etc.)

Optional Additional Activities

Creation “Grab Bag”

Supplies

Bag with mystery items: flashlight, feather, rock, shell, flower/leaf, small bottle of dirt, small bottle of water

Keep the bag hidden as you pull items out and talk about the creation of light, birds, land, fish and other sea life, plants, ocean, etc. using these props. Talk about how our Creator was the perfect designer and made all things with a purpose. Help the children think of ways the items are used and why God may have created them.
